



2016 CALIFORNIA LOCAL ELECTION RESULTS REGARDING CANNABIS
(organized alphabetically by county)

Alameda County

Measure EE – PASSED

City of Hayward passed up to 15% tax on all sales of med and rec cannabis

Measure NN – PASSED

City of San Leandro passed up to 10% tax on all sales of med and rec cannabis

Measure OO -- PASSED

City of San Leandro passed up to 10% tax for parking lot receipts and \$.10/sq ft of warehouse space (applies to all businesses, not just cannabis-related businesses)

Butte County

Measure L – FAILED

Medical cannabis still banned in Butte County

Calaveras County

Measure C – PASSED

Commercial cannabis taxes (med and rec):

Outdoor = \$2/sq ft canopy until tracking program instituted, then \$45/lb bud and \$10/lb trim

Indoor= \$5/ sq ft canopy until tracking, then \$70/lb bud and \$15/lb trim

Manufacturing= 7% of proceeds

Sales= 7%

Measure D – FAILED

Comprehensive regulations for cannabis businesses (defaults to state rules due to failure)

Contra Costa County

Measure J – PASSED

City of Pittsburg 10% tax on gross receipts of all med and rec cannabis businesses

Fresno County

Measure E – PASSED

City of Coalinga removed ban on commercial med and rec cannabis businesses



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Measure G – PASSED

City of Coalinga to allow 1 dispensary, to be taxed at 10% gross

Humboldt County

Measure T – PASSED

City of Rio Dell to permit cannabis businesses

Measure S – PASSED

Humboldt County imposes \$1 (outdoor)-\$3 (indoor)/sq ft tax on commercial cannabis cultivation

Inyo County

Measure G – PASSED

County of Inyo allows commercial medical cannabis businesses

Measure H – PASSED

County of Inyo allows commercial rec cannabis businesses

Measure I – PASSED

County of Inyo taxes 5% gross on commercial cannabis businesses (can be increased up to 12.5%), but cannot be more than \$1,250 per growing cycle for cultivations

Lake County

Measure C – PASSED

County of Lake commercial cannabis taxes= \$1/sq ft (outdoor), \$2/sq ft (mixed), \$3/sq ft (indoor)

Los Angeles County

Measure KK – PASSED

Carson City commercial cannabis tax= \$25/sq ft for cultivations and 18% of proceeds for all cannabis businesses

Measure MA – PASSED

City of Long Beach cannabis taxes= 6-8% for med dispensaries; 8-12% for rec dispensaries; 6-8% for processing, distributing, transporting or testing cannabis; \$12-15/sq ft for cultivation

Measure MM – PASSED

Removed city ban on marijuana businesses and implemented local cannabis regs

Measure X – FAILED

City of Avalon continues ban on cannabis businesses



Mendocino County

Measure AE – PASSED

City of Point Arena 7% tax on all rec cannabis businesses, 3% tax on all med cannabis businesses

Measure AF – FAILED

County of Mendocino rejected a broadening of the local commercial cannabis regs

Measure AI – PASSED

County of Mendocino 10% gross tax on dispensaries and grows; \$2,500 annual tax for cannabis distribution, delivery, manufacturing, nurseries and testing

Measure AJ – PASSED

County of Mendocino to use majority of cannabis tax income on cannabis enforcement, mental health, road repair, and fire and emergency services

Monterey County

Measure Y – PASSED

County of Monterey taxes= \$15/sq ft (until June 30, 2022, then \$25/sq ft) canopy; for nurseries, \$1.50/sq ft (\$5/sq ft by June 30, 2020=2); 5% on all other cannabis businesses (can be increased to 10%)

Measure A – PASSED

City of Del Ray Oaks 5% tax on all cannabis businesses (can be increased to 10%)

Measure J – PASSED

City of King taxes = \$25/sq ft for first 5,000 sq ft (med and rec), then \$10/sq ft thereafter; \$5/sq ft for nurseries; \$30,000 for manufacturing and testing

Measure W – PASSED

City of Gonzales taxes = \$25/sq ft for med cultivation; 15% gross for med manufacturing

Measure O – PASSED

City of Greenfield taxes = \$25/sq ft for cultivation; 10% gross for all other cannabis businesses (med and rec)

Measure L – PASSED

City of Salinas taxes = \$25/sq ft for cultivation; 10% gross for dispensaries, manufacturing, and delivery (med and rec)



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Orange County

Measure V – FAILED

City of Costa Mesa rejected allowing up to 8 medical cannabis businesses

Measure W – FAILED

City of Costa Mesa rejected allowing up to 4 medical cannabis businesses

Measure X – PASSED

City of Costa Mesa allows limited cannabis manufacturing, wholesale, transport, research, and testing, but not dispensaries

Measure KK – FAILED

City of Laguna Beach upheld ban on dispensaries (rejected measure for 2 dispensaries)

Placer County

Measure H – FAILED

City of Colfax upheld ban on cannabis businesses

Riverside County

Measure J – PASSED

City of Perris taxes = 10% on dispensaries

Measure K – PASSED

City of Perris adopts comprehensive local regs for cannabis businesses

Measure AA – PASSED

City of San Jacinto taxes = \$50/sq ft for cultivation or manufacturing; 15% gross for dispensaries

Measure P – PASSED

Cathedral City cannabis taxes expanded = \$25/sq ft; \$1 per g of concentrate or per unit of infused product

San Bernardino County

Measure N – PASSED

City of San Bernardino adopts comprehensive local regs for cannabis businesses

Measure O – PASSED, but loses to competitor Measure N

City of San Bernardino adopts comprehensive local regs for cannabis businesses

Measure P – FAILED



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City of San Bernardino competitor to Measures O and N for comprehensive local regs for cannabis businesses

Measure R – PASSED

City of Adelanto tax of up to 5% on all cannabis businesses

Measure U – FAILED

City of Upland upholds ban on cannabis businesses (rejecting proposal for 3 med businesses)

San Diego County

Measure N – PASSED

City of San Diego 5% tax on rec cannabis businesses (8% by July 1, 2019, and can be increased up to 15%)

Measure U – PASSED

City of La Mesa approved medical dispensaries and grows, and adopted regs for them

Measure V – FAILED

City of Lemon Grove did not repeal its dispensary ban

San Joaquin County

Measure P – PASSED

City of Stockton approved 4 medical dispensaries and 4 medical grows, and adopted regs for them

Measure Q – PASSED

City of Stockton passed 3.5-5% tax on gross revenue from all cannabis businesses

Santa Cruz County

Measure I – PASSED

City of Santa Cruz approved administrative measure to harmonize local rules and definitions regarding medical cannabis with those of the state pursuant to MMRSA

Measure E – PASSED

City of Santa Cruz approved administrative measure to harmonize local rules and definitions regarding medical cannabis with those of the state pursuant to MMRSA, and to widen use of existing marijuana taxes for local purposes

Measure L – PASSED

City of Watsonville cannabis taxes = \$20/sq ft of canopy; 2.5% of gross revenue for manufacturing infused products; 10% for sales of cannabis



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Measure M – PASSED

City of Watsonville measure for allocation of funds received from cannabis taxes (based on passage of Measure L)

Sierra County

Measure B – FAILED

Sierra County did not implement proposed limitations related to medical homegrows and medical caregivers

Siskiyou County

Measure Y – FAILED

City of Dunsmuir rejected adoption of comprehensive regs for cannabis homegrows

Solano County

Measure C – PASSED

City of Solano cannabis taxes = 15% of gross revenue for all cannabis businesses

Measure K – PASSED

City of Dixon cannabis taxes = 15% of gross revenue for all cannabis businesses

Sonoma County

Measure P – PASSED

City of Cloverdale cannabis taxes = 10% of gross revenue for all cannabis businesses

Venture County

Measure H – PASSED

City of Fillmore cannabis cultivation tax = \$30/sq ft for first 3,000 sq ft and \$15/sq ft for additional sq ft

Measure I – PASSED

City of Fillmore dispensary tax = 15% of all sales proceeds

Yuba County

Measure E – FAILED

Yuba County rejected comprehensive medical cannabis regs

Measure F – PASSED

City of Marysville cannabis taxes = initially 5% but can be increased to 15% for dispensaries; initially \$15/sq ft canopy for grows (but can be increased to \$25/sq ft)
